

River City Pistol Regional-----A NRA Registered Tournament W/Distinguished Revolver & CMP “Leg” Matches

Date: October 4-5, 2008 Evansville, Indiana

Sponsor: Daniel Boone Gun Club---Located on the North side of Hwy 62, 4 miles East of I-164 (Exit 9)

Eligibility: All competitors must be members of the National Rifle Association

Rules: Current NRA Conventional Pistol Rules will govern this Tournament

Awards: Regional Pins, Place and Team Medals furnished by the NRA. All other awards furnished by the Sponsor.

Classification/Categories: NRA classification system w/Civilian and Service Categories (All Police will shoot As Civilians)

Challenge Fee: \$1 per challenge returned if challenge is sustained.

Entries: Make entry by mailing SR-1 cards to: Ken Odom, POB 234, Haubstadt, IN 47639 or Phone 812-768-6621 or by e-mailing kwol@insightbb.com. Team entry made at the Range.

Entry Closing: Entries close at the beginning of firing each day. Team entries close at the beginning of the Firing of the Team Matches on either day. **No late Entry Fee**

Fees: \$45 package includes NRA Registration Fee & Distinguished Revolver Match. Individual Matches: \$5 Per Match plus NRA Registration Fee. Team Match fee: \$45 package or \$20 per team match.

Distinguished Revolver Match only: \$10

Registration: Registration and target assignment begins at 7 AM (CDT or EST) each day. Firing of the Distinguished Revolver Match will begin at 8 AM (CDT or EST) each day’, “2700” will Follow. Then the “Leg” Match and then the “Team” matches.

Firing Schedule: One (1) relay of 26 competitors each Day. All three (3) Team Matches fired each day Following the CMP “Leg” Match.

Special Notice: Competitors may fire entire “2700” in one (1) day.

TEAMS: A minimum of four (4) teams is required before the team matches will be fired.

Teams: Teams must comply with NRA Rules on make-up and must have four (4) firing members. Team Members may fire different relays. Team members must be listed when first member fires.

Award Schedule: Highest scoring competitor in each Match shall be declared the Winner and will not be Eligible for class/category awards. 1 award for each class/category that has at least 5 Competitors, 2 awards for 9 and 3 awards for 13.

Classes/Categories that have less than 5 competitors will be combined with the next higher Class/Category

Winner-----Gold Medallion

2nd Place-----Silver Medallion

3rd Place-----Bronze Medallion

Match #16---Winner, \$15, 1st in Class/Category--\$10, 2nd in C/C--\$6, 3rd in C/C--\$5

Matches # 5, #10, #15—Winner--\$10, 1st in C/C--\$8, 2nd in C/C—\$5, 3rd in C/C--\$4

All Fired Matches—Winner, \$8, 1st in C/C--\$6, 2nd in C/C--\$4, 3rd in C/C--\$3

Team Awards: Winner—4 Medals furnished by NRA. Monetary awards determined by Match Director.

Special Notes:

1. Competitors must score and change targets.
2. Bring your own drinks, no potable water on the range.
3. Awards made at the range if possible, otherwise they will be mailed.
4. Use of all scoring aids (except over lays) is restricted to range personnel.
5. Use of eye and ear protection is encouraged.
6. Light lunch served by the Club at no charge.
